

ORDINANCE NO. 742

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ITEMS
OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bellevue it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Bellevue to retain (i) any and all personal property located in the property recently acquired by the Village and commonly known as 325 S. Bellevue Ave., Bellevue, IL and (ii) the Village's crack sealer (the "Personal Property"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and Village Board find that the Personal Property is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by their sale.

Section 2. Pursuant to said Section 11-76-4, the President of the Village is authorized and directed to sell the Personal Property for a price, at a time and place and on such other terms and conditions as the President shall determine.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
