AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING, AT LARGE, OF LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for the owner or other person, firm or corporation, having control of any animal of the species of Horse, Ass, Mule, Cattle, Sheep, Goat or Swine, to cause, suffer or permit the same to run at large within the VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE.

SECTION 2. Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall be found guilty of violating any provision of this Ordinance, he shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Bollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Bollars for every offense and every day he shall violate any term or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication or posting, as required by law.
