AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to do, or cause to be done, any of the following acts within the corporate limits of the said VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE:

- (a) To park any vehicle within seven (7') feet of any fire hydrant or to park or place any vehicle or other obstruction or thing of any kind at such a place as to interfere with the use of any fire hydrant for fire purposes.
- (b) To park any vehicle within twenty (20') feet from the driveway of any fire station or any building within which fire trucks or police vehicles may be housed.
- (c) To follow any fire truck or police car at a distance of less than three hundred (300') feet or otherwise operate any vehicle so as to interfere with the operation of any fire truck or police car.
- (d) To drive any vehicle of any kind over any unguarded fire hose except at the direction of the fire chief or duly authorized police officers.
- (e) To operate any fire truck at a speed greater than thirty (30) miles per hour. 35 ?
- (f) To turn in, or cause, any false fire or police alarm.

SECTION 2. Upon the approach of any fire truck, police car or ambulance, traveling on an emergency mission, the operator of every other vehicle, upon audible signal by the operator of such fire truck, police car or ambulance, shall immediately drive such vehicle to a position as near as possible and parallel to the right-hand edge or curb of the street, clear of any intersection, and shall stop and remain in such position until such fire truck, police car or ambulance shall have passed, except when otherwise directed by a duly authorized police officer.

SECTION 3. Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall be found guilty of any violation of this Ordinance, such person, firm or corporation shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than One ~~(\$1.00)~~ Dollar nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense. 1000

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication or posting, as required by law.
