ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING COIN
OPERATED AMUSEMENT MACHINES AND DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees
of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as
follows:

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of
this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm
or corporation to operate, cause to be operated, permit to
be operated, or have available for operation on any premises
within the corporate limits of the said Village of Bellevue
any pin ball machine, picture machine, juke-box, or other
coin operated amusement machine ^{or cigarette machine} or device unless or until
such machine or device shall be duly licensed by the said
Village of Bellevue, as herein provided.

SECTION 2. The application for a license for any such
machine or device as is described in Section 1 of this
ordinance shall be made in writing to the ^{Clerk of} ~~President of the~~
~~Board of Trustees~~ of the said Village of Bellevue, and
shall contain a complete description of the machine or de-
vice sought to be licensed, including the name ~~type and~~
~~number~~, and such other descriptive information as shall
clearly identify said machine or device, including the name
and location at which the same is intended to be operated.
Such application shall be signed by the person, firm or cor-
poration applying for such license. Such applicant shall pay

with said application for license, the license fee provided for in this ordinance. When such application has been made, as herein provided, and the fee for such license paid, as herein provided, the ~~President of the Board of Trustees~~ ^{clerk of village} of said Village shall issue and deliver such license. Such license, when issued, shall be solidly attached to the machine or device for which the same is issued, and shall be displayed at all times during the life of said license on such machine or device. A separate application shall be made and a separate license fee paid for each machine or device sought to be licensed.

SECTION 3. Licenses for the machines and devices described in this ordinance may be paid annually or semi-annually, but must be paid in advance. An annual license may be issued only for the period commencing January 1st and ending December 31st of any one calendar year; a semi-annual license may be issued only for the period commencing January 1st and ending June 30th of any one calendar year, or for the period commencing July 1st and ending December 31st of any one calendar year. The annual license fee for each such machine or device described in this ordinance shall be SIXTY ^{25.00} (~~60.00~~) DOLLARS; and the semi-annual license fee for each such machine or device so described in this ordinance shall be THIRTY ^{12.50} (~~30.00~~) DOLLARS. No refunds or discounts shall be granted on any license fee when such license is applied for after the commencement of the term for which the same is issued, nor when any such license, after issuance, has been revoked, abandoned, terminated, or otherwise unused during the period for which the same may be issued.

SECTION 4. The President of said Board of Trustees of said Village of Bellevue may, after good cause is shown, revoke any license provided for under or issued in pursuance to the terms and provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. All persons, firms or corporations who shall operate, cause to be operated, permit to be operated, or have available for operation any pin ball machine, picture machine, juke-box, or other coin operated amusement machine or device on any premises within the corporate limits of said Village of Bellevue without a license for said machine or device, as provided in this ordinance, or who shall in any manner violate any term or provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$ 10, nor more than \$ 200, for each offense, and each day that any such person, firm or corporation shall so violate any term or provision of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense and punishable accordingly.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by publication or posting, as required by law.

SECTION 7. No term, provision or section of this ordinance shall be construed to authorize the licensing or operation of any coin operated gambling machine or device.
