

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, COMMENCING JULY 1, 1946 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1947.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
