ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE MOVEMENT OF
VEHICLES, MACHINERY AND ARTICLES OVER STREETS
IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of
the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1. The following streets and highways in the said
Village of Bellevue, Illinois are hereby designated as "improved
streets:"

- (a) Bellevue Avenue from Illinois Route #116 to Closen Avenue;
- (b) Closen Avenue from Bellevue Avenue to Anna Avenue;
- (c) Anna Avenue from Closen Avenue to Illinois Route #116;
- (d) All other streets and highways within said Village of Bellevue hereinafter designated as "improved streets" by ordinance of the said Village of Bellevue.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation shall move or
direct, control or cause the movement of any of the following de-
scribed vehicles, machinery or articles over, along, upon or across
any part of an "improved street" designated in Section 1. of this
ordinance or hereinafter designated by ordinance of the Village of
Bellevue:

- (a) Vehicles, machinery or articles with metal wheel treads for metal tires or track type treads, which wheel treads, tire or track type treads have mounted thereon any block, stud, flange, cleat, ridge, lug or any projection extending beyond the tread or traffic surface of such wheel, tire or tread;
- (b) Vehicles, machinery or articles with metal wheel treads or metal tires or track type treads, which wheel treads, metal tires or track type treads are less than six (6) inches in width when the gross over-all weight of such vehicles, machinery or articles, including load of Twenty-five Hundred (2500) Pounds or more;
- (c) Vehicles, machinery or articles having a gross over-all weight, including load, ~~of ten (10) tons or more;~~ *question load capabilities of streets.*
- (d) Vehicles, machinery or articles, the movement of which is likely to or does result in damage to the surface of such street,

provided, however, that this Section shall not apply to the movement of any such vehicle if the same is moved along, over, upon, or across such "improved street" on planks or mats in such a manner as to result in no damage to such street or the surface thereof.

SECTION 3. No person, firm or corporation shall move or direct, control or cause the movement of any vehicle or machine or article having a gross weight exceeding Four thousand (4000) Pounds over, along, upon or across any part of North Anna Avenue from Illinois Route #116 to Oakview Drive in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois. *Change To read The same as new signs - 4 Ton*

SECTION 4. Every person, firm or corporation who shall violate any term or provision of this ordinance or shall do or perform or cause to be done or performed any act which shall result in damage to any street or the surface thereof within the said Village of Bellevue shall be liable to the said Village of Bellevue for the amount of such damage to be recovered by the said Village of Bellevue in a civil action in any court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 5. All persons, firms or corporations who shall violate any term or provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10) nor more than Two hundred Dollars (\$200) for each offense.

SECTION 6. All terms and provisions of prior ordinances of the Village of Bellevue in conflict with the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
