

ORDINANCE NO. 63

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE BONDING OF THE  
MARSHAL FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,  
PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees and the President of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village Marshal for the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois be, and he is, hereby required to furnish to and file with the said Village of Bellevue a bond executed by himself as principal with some qualified, reputable surety company as surety in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000), conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties as such Village Marshal, to be approved by the Board of Trustees and the President of the said Village of Bellevue.

SECTION 2: That all Village Marshals hereafter appointed by said Village shall furnish and file the bond herein provided in Section 1 of this ordinance within 30 days after their appointment as such Village Marshals and that upon the filing and approval of such bonds, as herein provided, the premium for the same shall be paid by the said Village of Bellevue out of its General Corporate Fund.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances of the said Village of Bellevue adopted prior to the effective date of this ordinance and in conflict with this ordinance or any part thereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
