ORDINARCE NO. 1/2

AN OPDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ANNEXING TERRITORY USED FOR A HIGHWAY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoris County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION L. That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 24, Section 7, subsection 6, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1953, the following described real property is annexed to the Village of Bellevue; Peoria County, Illinois:

A part of Sections 10 and 11 in Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 at the westerly limits of the Village of Bellovue, Peoria County, Illinois, thence in a northerly direction to the north edge of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8, thence on an easterly direction along and upon the north edge of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 to a point on the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 that is located northeasterly from the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 at the easterly limits of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, thence in a westerly direction along the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 to the point of beginning, situate, lying and being in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois.

SECTION 2. It is the intention of this ordinance to annex all of that north half of that highway known as State Route 116 and 8 that lies contiguous to the south half of the highway that is presently incorporated in the Village.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due recording as required by law.
