Trustees of the Village of Bellavae, Tilinois, as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance Number 72 of the Ordinances of the Village of Bollevue, Illinois, entitled, "An Ordinance Regulating the Parking of Cars in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois," is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II. Henceforth, it shall be unlawful to allow any passenger automobile, truck, motorbus, tractor, trailer, wagon, cart, road scraper, or any combination thereof, or any other vehicle of any kind, regardless of its primary or incidental utility, to be parked on the public streets or highways within the confines of the Village of Bellevue for a period of more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

SECTION III. Any person, firm or company who shall have been found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (2100.00) for each 24 consecutime hour violation.
