AN ORDINANCE REESTABLISHING A
POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE
OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance Number 107 of the Ordinances of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, entitled "Ordinance Establishing a Police Department of the Village," is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II. There shall be employed by said Village of Bellevue, a police force of not more than four (4) officers.

SECTION III. That the President of the Village of Bellevue is hereby empowered to hire and dismiss said police officers, and that any such appointments shall be confirmed by the Board of Trustees.

SECTION IV. That the President of the Village of Bellevue may designate one of the Officers appointed as the Chief of Police of the Village of Bellevue.

SECTION V. All pay and allowances to Officers appointed shall be governed by the rules and regulations promulgated by the Public Health and Safety Committee of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication or posting as required by law.
