AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS; ANNEXING TERRITORY USED FOR A HIGHWAY.

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 24, section 7, subsection 8, Illinois Revised Statutes 1957, the following described real property is hereby annexed to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois: all of the highway and right of way of the highway known as State route 116 and 8 commencing at a point known as State Route 116 and 8 at the easterly boundaries of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois; and thence in an easterly direction to a point known as the easterly boundary of the township of Limestone, Peoria County, Illinois and the westerly boundary of the City of Peoria, Peoria County, Illinois, also known as the intersection of Seventh, Lincoln, and Laramie Streets of the City of Peoria, Peoria County, Illinois.

Section 2. It is the intention of this Ordinance to annex all of the highway property known as State route 116 and 8 from the easterly limits of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, to the westerly limits of the City of Peoria, Peoria County, Illinois.

Section 3. That the Ordinance be in full force and effect after its passage and due recording as required by law.


