AN ORDINANCE ANYEXING TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

TRACT I: A part of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Frincipal Meridian, more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of sail quarter section; thence West to the Northwest corner of the East half of said quarter section; thence South to the right of way of the love Central Railroad; thence East along said right of way line to the East line of said quarter section; thence North to the place of beginning; in Peoria County, 111inois;

TRACT II: That part of the South Half of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11 in Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, which lies South of the small run or creek running through said tract adjoining and Southwesterly of the Plank Road as traveled on May 26, 1890, and Westerly of the Westerly line of Lot 3 in Mulligan's Subdivision of parts of the South half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian; in Peoria County, Illinois;

TRACT III: Lot 3 in Mulligan's Subdivision of parts of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, excepting therefrom that part of said Lot 3 heretofore sold and conveyed by Frederick F. Martia and Ellen Martin, his wife, to Catherine Hass, by deed dated April 9, 1912, and recorded in the Recorder's Office of said Peoria County in Book 290, page 202; in Peoria County, Illinois;

TRACT IV: Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 8 North, kange 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the West line of said Quarter Section 742.50 feet North of the Southwest corner of said Quarter Section, the same being the intersection of the South line of Bellevue Heights, a subdivision in said Quarter Section, and the West line of said Quarter Section; thence South 80.6 feet; thence East 1410.9 feet, more or less, to a run or creek running through said Quarter Section and adjoining and Southwesterly of Plank Road as traveled on May 26. 1890; thence North along the line of said run or creek to a point due East of the place of beginning; thence West to the place of beginning; in Peoria County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by ERWIN DOELBAR and CAROLINE DOELBAR, the owners of record of the land hereinafter described was filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue on October 14, 1958, and which Petition requested

annexation of the territory hereinafter described, which is contiguous to the Village of Bellevue and which is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, and upon which no electors reside.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue have considered the question of the annexation of the territory hereinafter described and has determined that the request of said Petitioners should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the territory hereinafter described, said territory being contiguous and not within the corporate limits of any municipality, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Bellevue in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes, Section 7, Subsection 6(a). The territory annexed is shown by the hatched lines on the map hereto attached, which is hereby made a part of this ordinance, is known and described as follows:

TRACT I: A part of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Quarter Section; thence West to the Northwest corner of the East Half of said Quarter Section; thence South to the right of way of the Iowa Central Railroad; thence East along said right of way line to the East line of said Quarter Section; thence North to the place of Deginning; in Feoria County, Illinois;

TRACT II: That part of the South Half of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11 in Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, which lies South of the small run or creek running through said tract adjoining and Southwesterly of the Plank Road as traveled on May 26, 1890, and Westerly of the Westerly line of Lot 3 in Kulligan's Subdivision of parts of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian; in Peoria County, Illinois;

- (c) That this patition is hereby filed with the Clerk of the Village of Bellevue for the purpose of obtaining the annexation of this territory, along with a plat indicating the position of the property in relation to the present Village limits of the Village of Bellevue and we hereby request the clerk that such annexation be submitted to the corporate authorities of the said Village of Bellevue for final action.
