

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISCHARGING OF
FIREARMS IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA
COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Ordinance # 136

Keep

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the
Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall fire or discharge any gun, pistol,
or other firearm within the Village, except on the premises used by
a duly licensed shooting gallery, gun club or rifle club.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section One of this ordinance
shall not apply to sheriffs, coroners, constables, members of the
police department, or other peace officers engaged in the discharge
of their official duties, or to any person summoned by any such
officers to assist in making arrests or preserving the peace, while
such person so summoned is engaged in assisting such officer.

SECTION 3. Weapons used in violation of this ordinance shall
be forfeited to, and confiscated by the village, in addition,
anyone found guilty of violation of Section One of this ordinance
shall be fined not less than TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 (\$25.00)
DOLLARS or more than ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS,
for each offense and conviction.
