An Ordinance Prohibiting Perking of Vehicles in Specified Places in the Village (Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.

Be it ordained by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoric County, Illinois, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or official traffic sign or signal:

- (1) In any interacction;
- (2) In a crosswalk;
- (3) Upon any bridge or viacuet, or in any subway and the approach thereto;
- (4) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty feet of a point on the curb immediately opposite either end of a safety zone;
- (5) Within thirty feet of an official traffic signal or a through atrect sign on the approaching side;
- (6) Within twenty feet of a crossmalk at an intersection;
- (7) At any cush within fifteen feet of a fire hydrent;
- (8) Within twenty feet of the driveray entrance () thy fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy-five feet of the entrance, when properly signposted;
- (9) At any place whose the standing of any vehicle will block the use of any driveway;
- (10) On any sidewalk;
- (11) Alongside of or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
- (12) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curh of a street;
- (12) At any place where official traffic signs have been erected prohibiting stopping, standing and parking;
- (14) Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a steam or interurban railway crossing;
- (18) Along the side of or at the end of any medium strip of dividing perhaps of any street;
- (16) In any bus locking zenc;

(17) In an alley, except for the purpose of expeditious loading or unloading, and while loading or unloading, such operator shall leave available at least eight feet of width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such a position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property;

Any person, firm or company who shall have been found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, for each offense.
