

ORDINANCE NO. 187

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OR BURNING OF GARBAGE AND DESIGNATING TYPE OF CONTAINING, WITH FINE FOR VIOLATIONS, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village Board deem it necessary in the public welfare and health of this community, as well as the comforts of its citizens, to provide certain restrictions against open disposal of garbage, the burning thereof, and providing containers for the sanitary disposal thereof, in this village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, deposit, dump or discard any garbage, table refuse, straw from animal bedding, waste paper, cartons, vegetable cuttings, sawdust or waste, upon any lot, parcel or tract as a method of disposal, fill, or litter, or to suffer or permit any lot, parcel or tract to be used for such purposes.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any garbage, waste, table refuse, straw from animal bedding, waste paper, cartons, or other items classed as garbage, in this village.

SECTION 3. All garbage, vegetable waste, cartons, and table scraps, shall be wrapped in paper and placed in a garbage can, the size of which shall not exceed 20 gallon in capacity, covered with a fly tight lid, and placed on collection day, at the front of the lot line or alley, as the case may be, where the established garbage route has been designated.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for garbage, designated in paragraph 3 above, to be placed in the garbage can in wet stage, but it shall be wrapped so that the wrapping on the outside of dry to prevent against sticking or freezing in the can.

SECTION 5. Garbage containers larger than 20 gallon capacity, are unlawful and shall not be used, nor shall containers that are not covered with fly tight lids.

SECTION 6. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) nor more than FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), and each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate violation and fined accordingly.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval thereof and the due publication according to law.

SECTION 8. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed as to such conflict, otherwise such other ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.
