ORDINANCE NO. *188*

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PROVIDING A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. No person shall drive any vehicle upon any street or roadway of this Village at a speed which (1) is greater than is reasonable and proper with regard to traffic conditions and ~~the use of the street or roadway, or (2) outside of an urban district, the~~ ^{to and from the place or property} maximum shall be ~~65~~ ⁵⁵ miles per hour, and in an urban district the maximum is 30 miles per hour, except that in an alley the maximum is 15 miles per hour. The fact that the speed of a vehicle does not exceed the applicable maximum speed limit does not relieve the driver from the duty to decrease speed when approaching and crossing an intersection, when approaching or going around a curve, when approaching a hill crest, when traveling on any narrow or winding roadway, or when special hazards exist with respect to school zones, pedestrians or other traffic or be reason of weather or highway conditions; and speed shall be decreased as may be necessary to avoid colliding with any person or vehicle on or entering the highway or street in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all persons to use due care. In addition, all vehicles shall be driven on State highways in this Village at a speed no greater than that posted by the Highway authority having jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be fined not less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed as to such conflict, otherwise they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4.

Nothing in this ordinance fixing the maximum speed emergency vehicle*

of vehicles shall apply to authorized emergency vehicles when responding to an emergency call or are operated under emergency circumstances.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and the due publication thereof as provided by law.
