ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PART OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE FOURTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, SITUATED, LYING AND BEING IN THE COUNTY OF PEORIA AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Village Clerk, a duly Certified copy of an Order entered by the Circuit Court of the Tenth Judicial Circuit at Peoria County, Illinois, dated June 19, 1970, submitting the question of the annexation of certain described territory to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, to the Village's corporate authorities for final action on said question of annexation, and

WHEREAS, it appears from said Order that the territory therein described and it is found by this Board to be a compact territory and is contiguous with the existing boundaries of this Village and connected therewith by a substantial parcel along the southerly and easterly line of said tract sought to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, is is found that said described territory is not within the corporate boundary of any other municipality, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that all of the findings of the Court are correct, and it now becomes the duty of the President and Board of Trustees of this Village of Bellevue to act upon the Order submitting the question of the final annexation of said territory to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation this Village Board finds that it is to the best interest of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, that said described territory be annexed to and made a part of this Village and incorporated within the corporate limits hereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the tract or parcel of land or territory more fully described and designated as follows:

Part of Section 10, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, more fully described as follows:

- a.) The South 174.4 feet of the Wouthwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10;
- b.) The Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, excepting therefrom Lots 1, 2, 14, 15 and the west 65 feet of Lot 16 in Eisele Place, a Subdivision;
- c.) All of Lulay Subdivision in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10;
- d.) The North 50 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 10;
- e.) That part of the South 300 feet of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 10 lying East of the Westerly right-of-way line of Maxwell Road;
- f.) That part of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 10 North of the Southerly right-of-way line of State Route 116 and East of the westerly right-of-way line of Maxwell Road, extended,

all situated, lying and being in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, and the same is hereby incorporated within the boundaries of this Village and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the plat or map, hereunto attached and expressly made a part hereof, correctly and accurately shows the territory hereby annexed to this Village, both as to the existing boundaries prior to and the relation of the newly annexed tract, aforesaid, to this Village, and that said map or plat is true, correct and exact map or plat and is hereby made the official plat of the territory and shall be recorded with this ordinance and as a part hereof.

SECTION 3. That upon the taking effect of this 'rdinance, the Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, shall record the map together with a duly certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Recorder of Peoria County, Illinois, and furnish a copy to the County Clerk and such other agencies as may have occasion for such copies.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by at least a two-thirds favorable vote of the number of members of the Village Board entitled to hold office on the Village Board and the approval thereof by the Village President, as provided for by law.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealled.

Passed by upwards of a two-thirds vote favoring adoption of this ordinance by the total number of officials entitled to membership on the Village Board of Trustees in regular, public session assembled this 24% day of June, A. D. 1970.


