ORDINANCE NO. 207

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 205 PERTAINING TO PARKING PROSIBITION IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLACE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 205, is hereby smended, and in its place, seid Section shall reed as follows:

of the proceeding sections may be towed away and impounded by the Police Department, and the owner or person in custody of such of the tow truck if a charge is made for a call, plus a fine, as hereinsfter stated:

a.) For violating Section 1 of this ordinance, the fine shell be \$2.00 for each offense, if peid within 5 days of the issuence of the ticket. Thereefter, the fine shell be \$5.00, if not peid within said 5 days after issuence.

b.) For violating Section 2 of this Ordinance, the fine shall be not less then \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00,

No vehicle shall be removed from being impounded until both the fine and tow are paid, and any person who illegally removed or takes such impounded vehicle shall be fined not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00. All parking fines may be paid at the office of the Village Clerk, together with tow charges, if any.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and the publication thereof, and such publication is hereby ordered to be in pamphlet form and made conveniently available to the public.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts or ordinance in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealled.
