

ORDINANCE NO. 256

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 215, BY ELIMINATING CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSES, SETTING CLOSING HOURS FOR ALL TAVERNS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1978, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That effective as of January 1, 1978, all Class "B" Tavern Licenses are terminated, leaving only the Class "A" Tavern Liquor License, at which time All Class "A" Taverns within the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, shall close promptly and be vacated of all patrons by the Hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., and they shall remain closed and cleared of patrons until the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M. each day of the week, EXCEPTING Sunday, when said tavern shall remain closed until the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M.

SECTION 2. That effective as of January 1, 1978, there shall be not more then six (6) Class "A" Tavern licenses to operate within the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, at any one time. The Class "B" licenses on said date shall cease to exist.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provises of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, as to such conflict.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and the due publication thereof, effective, however, as of January 1, 1978, in manner and form as provided for by law.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LOAD LIMIT ON STARR LANE IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND FIXING A FINE FOR VIOLATORS

WHEREAS, Starr Lane in the Village of Bellevue is being subjected to heavy truck and traffic loads, and

WHEREAS, the base material and bituminous surface are not of sufficient depth or thickness to stand vehicular loads of over 8,000 pounds, gross weight, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to protect the use of this lane by limiting load weights.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby imposed a vehicular load limit of 8,000 pounds, gross weight, on Starr Lane, in the Village of Bellevue, in order to protect the surface of said lane.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation operating any vehicle having a gross weight in excess of 8,000 pounds over, along or upon Starr Lane, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than fifteen dollars (\$15.00), nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, plus costs.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation causing damage to the surface of Starr Lane by operating any vehicle carrying a gross weight of 8,000 pound, or more, shall be subject to costs or repairs for damages done to said roadway in addition to the fine, aforesaid.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided for by law, and the same is hereby ordered to be published by the Village Clerk, instantler, and making copies conveniently available.
