# ORDINANCE NO. 284 671

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF STARR LANE

#### BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE:

SECTION 1. A local improvement shall be made in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois; the nature, character, locality, and description shall be as follows:

#### STARR LANE

The Roadway of Starr Lane shall consist of the removal of 933 L.F. of existing pavement and replacement with construction of a twenty-four (24) foot P.C.C. pavement, 8" thick with three (3) foot aggregate shoulders, 8" thick, together with regrading of ditches and drainage structures south a total distance of 933' including a bituminous taper of approximately 45' from the south edge of Illinois Route 116.

All items of material and construction described herein and as shown on the plans for the proposed improvement shall conform in strict accordance with the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" as adopted by the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois on October 1, 1979, and as subsequently revised.

#### CONFORMANCE TO PLANS:

Wherever herein the description of the locations of this improvement there is any duplication of locations, no duplication of the improvement is intended, or shall be made and the said improvement shall be constructed in good and workmanlike manner to conform to the plans attached hereto and made a part hereof.

All materials used in the construction of this improvement not specifically herein described shall be of good quality and suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used.

All of the above described improvements shall be constructed under the direction and supervision and to the satisfaction of the Board of Local Improvements, and all the necessary labor and work shall be performed in a good and workmanlike manner.

### ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION:

For the purpose of constructing this improvement in accordance with the elevations, dimensions and positions as herein provided for, the grades and lines of construction shall be given by use of stakes and other necessary devices as the work progresses; and to protect those benefited by this improvement from the use of improper material and poor workmanship, all material used shall be inspected, and all labor performed shall be superintended. To this end, the Board of Local Improvements shall employ the necessary competent engineers, inspectors and superintendents during the construction of the work.

All work in connection with the improvement herein provided for shall be executed in a good and workmanlike manner and under the superintendence of the Board of Local Improvements.

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- SECTION 2. That the recommendation of the Board of Local Improvements and the estimate of the cost thereof, both hereto attached, be, and the same are hereby approved.
- SECTION 3. That said improvement shall be made and the whole cost thereof, together with an amount not exceeding six (6) percent of the estimated cost to-wit: SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY NINE AND 22/100 Dollars (\$6,689.22) which is hereby provided for to apply toward the payment of all lawful costs and expenses incurred in making, levying and collecting the assessment for said improvement, being the amount included in the estimate therefore, shall be paid for by special assessment in accordance with Article 9 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes as amended.
- SECTION 4. That the aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed and each individual, assessment, and the amount to be assessed against the Village of Bellevue as public benefits, shall be divided into ten installments which shall bear interest at the current maximum rate of interest per annum until paid, all in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Article 9 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes as amended.
- SECTION 5. That the several and respective installments of the amounts that may be assessed against the Village of Bellevue for and on account of public benefits, and confirmed by the Court, shall be paid out by the Comptroller out of any money arising from the collection of the direct annual tax provided for in and by Section 9-2-39 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, as amended, and out of any other money in his hands that may be used for that purpose, including any sum allotted to the Village of Bellevue of its share of the Motor Fuel Tax collected by the State of Illinois, the use for such purpose having been previously approved and designated for such purpose, as provided by law.
- SECTION 6. That for the purpose of anticipating the collection of the second and succeeding installments of said assessment for said improvement bonds shall be issued payable out of such installments, bearing interest at the current maximum rate per annum, payable annually, and signed by such officers as prescribed by the Municipal Code of Bellevue and the Illinois Revised Statutes. Said bonds shall be issued in accordance with, and shall in all respects conform to the provisions of Article 9 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes as amended.
- SECTION 7. That the Superintendent of Special Assessments for the Village of Bellevue, be and he is hereby directed to file a petition in the Circuit Court of the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Illinois, Peoria County, as provided by law in the name of the municipality, praying

that steps may be taken to levy a special assessment for said improvement, in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and in the manner prescribed by law.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage and approval according to law.
