Regular Board Meeting

November 11, 2014

Mayor Terry Johnson called the meeting to order @ 7:00pm

Board Present: Sandra Cooper, Aaron Lannert, George Schuettler, Francis Heskett, Bill Johnson, Chad Murphy.

Also Present: Attorney Lane Alster

Motion by Bill Johnson to accept minutes from October 28, 2014 board meeting second by George Schuettler- 5 ayes.

Motion by Bill Johnson to pay bi-monthly expenses second by Chad Murphy - 5 ayes.

Barefoot Bob's (Ron & Hal) asked to be removed from the agenda due to illness

Terry Johnson asks for motion to accept tax levy ordinance #688. Chad Murphy makes motion to accept ordinance / second by Bill Johnson – 5 ayes motion carried

Motion by Bill Johnson to add class "B" liquor license (restaurant class) ordinance #689 / with restrictions regarding sleeping accommodations and hours of selling alcoholic liquors are 11am to 11 pm. Second by Chad Murphy – 5 ayes motion carried

Truck tires at a price of \$1462.00 from East Peoria Tire Company: Motion by Bill Johnson to purchase tires second by Chad Murphy – 5 ayes motion carried

Rich Stoneburner: asks about Byron Ct. property Lane states they would talk about it later, Rich says the property at 643 Ridgeview is taken care of, also states there is a garbage problem @ 5609 Hivue, he is addressing that issue.

Jay Williams asks if he has the go ahead for the old Kmart building regarding the medical marijuana cultivating center. Mayor Johnson tells him the board is in agreement and he does have the go ahead.

Mary Tribett: states she is here regarding Bellevue hardware, Terry Johnson told her it had been removed from the agenda awaiting more input from the board

Steve Wilson: Bosch Road is almost complete.

Larry Estep: inquires about running for the board, Sandra Cooper will get paperwork to him

Aaron Lannert asks about the sign on route 116. Sign belongs to the village and village will post website info. and other village announcements. Aaron also asks about the money received from video gaming in

the village, can the money be set aside for parks and recreation purposes? Mayor Johnson replied "he doesn't think we need to do that. Board will discuss.

George Schuettler: nothing

Francis Heskett: residents would like to see Perkins Trucking area cleaned up also Smith's property on Plank Rd. when will the orange barrels be removed from the lot on Plank road?

Bill Johnson: asks if anyone else seen in the Limestone Independent News that Bellevue owes delinquent taxes? Lane explained these are in regards to the property recently purchased on Main St. and are in the process of being straightened out. Bill asks if Steve could keep the board informed of progress of building permits in the village esp. Casey's and the Dollar General Store. Bill also said the blacktop by Buhs Trucking looks as though it is finished, by the owner.

Chad Murphy: questions the house w/tarp still on the roof. Lane replied that the property is in foreclosure and many times the banks will not pay fines.

Lane: says that Mike Seghetti would like to know the water leak on Anna has been repaired. Regarding the school signs, the school has to contact IDOT for approval to remove the signs.

Terry Johnson: shows a proposed project for next year involving leveling the hill in front of Glen's Autobody from TIF funds. Will be discussed further at next meeting. Greg Ives has more properties to annex into Bellevue and possibly Midwest Sales will annex. In return Greg Ives would like a discount on property taxes.

Officer Hoffman: mentions talking to the fire chief regarding medical information holder to be placed in refrigerator of residents in case of emergency.
