Advised that Katherine St., was being monitored for vehicles that run stop signs. Informed the Board Members of recent Theft @ I.R. Here Tap.

Speaker, Denny Merriman – Addressed the Board, about waiving permit fees for new ice cream facility being built. Mr. Merriman inquired about TIF District, funding and is it available?

Chairman Johnson – Explained how funding could be used, application process & who to correspond with. Drawings with cost per project would be needed. Chairman Johnson, explained a TIF, agreement would have to be drawn up, reviewed by Board Members and approved. Speaker, 50/50 Mexican/American Restaurant, Socrates – Addressed the Board Members, about a liquor license for the restaurant.

Superintendent, Wilson – Informed Board Members, that Brinks, on Harmon Hwy., would like the Village to put in a sidewalk. Sidewalk would connect to Casey's and run past their property. Superintendent, Wilson, discussed with Board Members, that Dave Crum, called E.P.A., on run-off water from back side of his property. Wilson, explained about where water drains from and what has been done over the years.
