

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-3

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLCY REGARDING FAIR HOUSING PRACTICES IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE.

WHEREAS, it is a violation of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (also known as the "Fair Housing Act") to discriminate on several bases in the sale or rental of housing; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the fact that such discrimination is already against federal and state law, it is advantageous for municipalities and other units of general local government to take a role in fighting such discrimination; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed worthwhile for the Village of Bellevue to establish a policy of its own in an effort to protect its citizens against being discriminated against in the availability of decent and sanitary housing because of race, color, religion, sex, familial status, or national origin pursuant to 42 USC Sec. 3604; and

WHEREAS, in the event any village official who becomes aware of or receives a complaint of a resident's or potential resident's civil rights in terms of housing discrimination being violated, he or she shall refer the matter to the Village Board ; and

WHEREAS, it shall be incumbent on the Village Board to report said notice or complaint of a fair housing law violation to the proper federal or state authorities for action; **NOW**

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue that the intent of the foregoing statements become the policy regarding civil rights violations described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in accordance to law.


