

ORDINANCE NO. 790

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 446
LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE
(NUMBER OF LICENSES)

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees passed An Ordinance to Regulate the Sale of Alcoholic Liquor, Ordinance No. 446, on April 14, 1997, such Ordinance regulating all aspects of the sale of alcoholic liquor within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/4.1) provides that municipalities may regulate the number of liquor licenses issued within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that the best interest of the Village will be served if the number of liquor license made available for issuance is limited;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

2.4: Number of Licenses. In no event shall a license issue if such issuance will result in there being more licenses outstanding in a particular classification than the number herein specified:

Class A	(tavern)	2
Class A-1	(extended hours)	1
Class B	(restaurant)	1
Class C	(package)	2
Class F	(beer and wine)	2
