- II. Approval of minutes from last meeting-08.11.2020- Leroy Wiseman Motioned – Aaron Lannert 2nd- All in favor.
- III. Approval of Bills-8.25.2020- Marty Schuettler Motioned- Dean Merriman 2nd- All in favor.
- IV. Discussion from Residents- None Present
- V. Discussion from Board- Jenny Wilson & Leroy Wiseman Nothing.
