### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING DATES:

- **Annual Village Wide Garage Sale** – Saturday, June 19, 2021.
- **Clean -Up Days** – We will start picking up at 8:00 am. Items for pick up must be at the curb no later than 2:00 pm on June 23, 2021 and September 8, 2021. Items put out days before below listed dates or left out after scheduled list dates will not be picked up and are subject to fines. Please remember no paint, tires, electronics or yard waste.

  - ❖ Tuesday, September 7, 2021 & Wednesday, September 8, 2021
- **Rabies Clinic** – Due to COVID-19 we could not find a Vet that was willing to come and do an animal clinic this year.

### THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE BOARD WOULD LIKE TO REMIND YOU OF A FEW OF OUR ORDINANCES:

- **GARBAGE:** All garbage must be kept in cans with tight fitting lids. Cans are to be kept at the rear of the property except on pickup day. **All garbage must be picked up weekly.** If you haul your own garbage, it must be taken to the dump weekly.
- **PETS:** All pets are to be kept on a leash or in a fenced yard. If there is a problem with dogs/cats running loose, please contact the Peoria County Animal Control at 691-9069. We also have a problem with people letting their pets do their business in other people's yards. When walking your pets, please clean up after them.
- **BURNING:** No burning of garbage. Recreational fires must be put out by 11:00 pm. Please make sure you have a hose nearby to put out the fire if it starts to spread.
- **LITTERING:** We have a problem with littering in the Village. Anyone caught littering will receive a stiff fine with no warning issued.
- **PARKING:**
  - ❖ No parking on Village right-of-ways from midnight to 6:00 am.
  - ❖ Absolutely no parking on Village sidewalks for any reason.
  - ❖ Please do not park in your yard for any extended length of time or you will be fined. All vehicles must be parked on gravel, concrete or blacktop.
  - ❖ No parking on Village streets when a snowfall of 2" or more is predicted so the street crew can get the streets plowed in a timely manner.

Please make sure you contact the Village before doing any construction projects, new fences, swimming pools (above ground or in ground), etc. to see if you need a permit.
