ORDINANCE NO. 834

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ITEM OF PERSONAL PROPERTY (SKID-STEER)

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bellevue it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Bellevue to retain a Bobcat S-185 skid-steer loader (the "Personal Property"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and Village Board find that the Personal Property is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by their sale.

<u>Section 2</u>. Pursuant to said Section 11-76-4, the President of the Village is authorized and directed to sell the Personal Property by advertising for bids in a newspaper in general circulation within the Village, with bids to be opened on May 27, 2024.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
