

RESOLUTION NO. 24- 4

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT
OF THE VILLAGE CLERK

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-25-90 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-90) (the "Act") provides that any Village of fewer than 5,000 inhabitants may, by resolution adopted by not less than two-thirds of the Village Board, choose to have a clerk appointed by the Village President with the concurrence of the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, fewer than 5,000 inhabitants live in the Village of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that the best interest of the Village and its inhabitants will be served by having the clerk appointed as set forth in the Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village Board finds as fact the recitals set forth above.

SECTION 2: That effective immediately the Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue shall be appointed by the Village President with the concurrence of the Village Board of Trustees.

SECTION 3: That the Village President and the Village Clerk shall take all steps necessary and proper to carry out the intent of this resolution.
