VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE APPOINTING A ZONING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Village has proposed to make certain changes to its Zoning Map and Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-13-14 of the Illinois Municipal Code (Ill.Rev.Stat., 1988, ch. 24, §11-13-14) provides that such changes may not be made without a hearing before a commission designated by the Board of Trustees of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-13-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (Ill.Rev.Stat., 1988, ch. 24, §11-13-2) provides that a zoning commission may be appointed by the President of the Village, subject to the confirmation of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that the best interests of the Village and its residents will be served by the creation of a Zoning Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It is hereby determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest that the Village appoint a Zoning Commission for the purpose of reviewing proposed changes to the Village Zoning Map and Zoning Ordinance.

Section 2: The President of the Village hereby appoints the Village Zoning Board of Appeals to act as the Zoning

Commission, such appointment being hereby confirmed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary and essential to carry out the terms of said Contract.
