ORDINANCE AMENDING LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 3.1(b) of Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 293 shall be deleted in its entirety, and the following section shall be added in its place:

(b) No person other than (i) the licensee of a licensed premises, (ii) any of the licensee's employees while actually in the performance of their duties, or (iii) any persons legitimately engaged by the licensee to render services to the licensee (whether or not employees) while actually in the performance of said services shall be permitted to enter or remain upon the premises, nor shall any person consume any alcoholic liquor on such premises, nor shall any alcoholic liquor be exposed upon such premises in any open individual serving container (including but not limited to glasses or beer bottles) beyond fifteen (15) minutes after the prescribed closing time to such licensed premises.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective as of the date of its passage.
