ORDINANCE NO. 411

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE ORDINANCE NO. 142

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section A: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 142 is hereby amended by increasing the minimum fine to Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

Section B: Ordinance No. 142, An Ordinance Prohibiting the Owner or Keeper of Animals from Allowing them to Run at Large, as amended by this Ordinance No. 411, is hereby restated in its entirety as follows:

SECTION I. Whoever shall permit any animal, including but not limited to, any dog, cat, horse, sheep, goat, hog, cow, mule, or chicken to run at large or to be at large within the limits of said Village shall subject himself to a fine of not less than TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 (\$25.00) DOLLARS and not more than TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS for each and every such offense. This Ordinance is intended to and does include animals of both sexes, and of any age.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

<u>Section C</u>: Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 44 is hereby repealed.

Section D: This Ordinance shall be effective upon the date of its passage as provided by law.
