## ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE ORDINANCE NO. 142

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section A: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 142 is hereby amended by increasing the minimum fine to Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

Section B: Ordinance No. 142 is hereby amended by
adding the following Section III:

SECTION III. Whoever shall permit any animal (excluding house pets such as dogs and cats), including but not limited to any horse, sheep, goat, hog, cow, mule or chicken, to be present in the Village, shall subject himself to a fine of not less than FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$50.00) DOLLARS and not more than TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS for each and every such offense. This Ordinance is intended to and does include animals of both sexes, and of any age.

Section C: This Ordinance shall be effective upon the date of its passage as provided by law.
