AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A DEDICATION OF RIGHT OF WAY FOR PUBLIC ROAD PURPOSES

WHEREAS, a Roadway Right of Way Plat ("Dedication") has been prepared by the Village of Bellevue covering certain property ("Premises") owned by C. Ray Woodhead and L. Jane Woodhead; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue have determined that the best interests of the Village and its residents will be served by the execution of the Dedication;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Village hereby approves the Dedication.

Section 2: That the proper officers of the Village are hereby authorized to evidence such approval by the execution and recordation of the Dedication Plat, and to take all other steps which are necessary and proper to effect such dedication.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
