## VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 446, LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE (NUMBER OF LICENSES)

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees passed An Ordinance to Regulate the Sale of Alcoholic Liquor, Ordinance No. 446, on April 14, 1997, such Ordinance regulating all aspects of the sale of alcoholic liquor within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/4.1) provides that municipalities may regulate the number of liquor licenses issued with their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that the best interest of the Village will be served if the number of liquor licenses made available for issuance is limited; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: It is hereby determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest that Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 446 (as amended by Ordinance No. 472) be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with the following:

<u>2.4.</u> Number of <u>Licenses</u>. In no event shall a license issue if such issuance will result in there being more licenses outstanding in a particular classification than the number herein specified:

Class A	- 4
Class A-1	- 1 · · · · · ·
Class B	- 0
Class C	- 3
Class F	- 0

Section Two: This Ordinance shall take effect as of the date hereof.
