ORDINANCE NO. 537

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS (OVERNIGHT)

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village of Bellevue Board of Trustees that the number of cars parking on Village streets during the night is creating problems for the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code authorizes municipalities to regulate the use of streets; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Parking Prohibited. It shall be unlawful for the operator or owner of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle, or allow such vehicle to stop, stand or park, on any public right of way within the Village of Bellevue between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m.

Section 2: Penalty. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) and not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).

Section 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the date of its passage and publication as provided by law.
