ORDINANCE NO. 589

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF BUSINESSES ENGAGED IN GARBAGE AND SEWER COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Village Board deems it necessary, in order to protect the public health and welfare of this community, to require a license issued by the Village for all businesses that operate within the confines of the limits of the Village of Bellevue and engage in garbage and or sewage collection and disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THE FOLLOWING:

Section 1.0: General

- <u>Section 1.1:</u> Village of Bellevue Ordinance #74 is hereby repealed.
- <u>Section 1.2:</u> Persons eligible for license issuance. Only companies or persons who comply in all respects with the applicable provisions of this Ordinance and other Ordinances of this Village shall be eligible for a license.
- <u>Section 1.3:</u> Duration of licenses. Licenses issued by the Village Board pursuant to this Ordinance shall be granted for a period of one (1) year.
- Section 1.4: Register of licenses. The Clerk of the Village of Bellevue shall at all times maintain a record of all licenses issued pursuant to this Ordinance. Such record shall be kept in the manner customary and in accordance with the general practices of the Clerk or pursuant to any other Village Ordinances. This record shall be available for public access upon written request.
- <u>Section 1.5:</u> Delegation. The Village Board may delegate any or all of its licensing power to any officer or official of the Village of Bellevue.
- <u>Section 1.6:</u> Fee. The fee to obtain a license to operate or engage in the business of garbage and or sewer collection and disposal services shall be twenty-five (\$25) dollars per year, payable to the City Treasurer.

Section 2.0: Vehicles and Equipment

- <u>Section 2.1:</u> Regulations. Every vehicle used in the collection and disposal of garbage and or sewage must at all times comply with all applicable regulations set forth under the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- Section 2.2: Identification. The license plate and VIN number of every vehicle used in the collection and disposal of garbage and or sewage must be recorded with the Clerk of the Village of Bellevue.

Section 2.3: Specifications. Every vehicle, and or container upon such vehicle, used in the collection and disposal of garbage and or sewage must be constructed in such a manner as to prevent entirely the escape of any of its contents. Each and every container used in the collection and or disposal of garbage or sewage must be constructed of such non-porous material as to allow for full disinfection and cleaning.

Section 2.4: Unnecessary Offensiveness. No vehicle for carrying any garbage, rubbish, sewage or having upon it or in it other nauseous or offensive substances shall, without necessity therefore, stand or remain near any building, place or business or other premises where any person may be. All vehicles engaged in the collection and disposal of garbage and or sewage, and any and all implements used in connection therewith, must at all times be in such a condition where no needless offense shall be given to any inhabitants of the Village or endanger the health of any person.

Section 3.0 Penalties

<u>Section 3.1:</u> Fine. Any person or company found in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than one-hundred (\$100) nor more than two-hundred (\$200) per violation per violation.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after the date of its passage.
