ORDINANCE NO. 657

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON SOUTH MAXWELL ROAD

WHEREAS, various streets within the Village are narrow; and,

WHEREAS, when automobiles and other motor vehicles are parked on certain streets, it becomes difficult to drive, turn around, back out of driveways and otherwise use the streets; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (65 ILCS 5/11-208) provides that corporate authorities of a municipality may adopt traffic regulations as provided therein; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Bellevue that parking be prohibited on certain streets within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Board of Trustees find as fact the recitals set forth above.

<u>Section 2</u>: Parking of automobiles or other motor vehicles on the following street is hereby prohibited between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.:

• The section of South Maxwell Road between West Closen Road and West Katherine Avenue.

Section 3: Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day that a vehicle is parked on any of the streets listed in Section 2 hereof shall be considered a separate violation.

<u>Section 4</u>: In addition to the penalty provided in Section 3 hereof, any vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance may be towed upon fulfillment of the notice requirements of Article II of Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 542.

<u>Section 5</u>: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and recordation as provided by law.
